The early pumpkin

- **Earlier in maturity**
- **Early AND healthy & high yielding**
- **For early start of harvest – long harvest window**

Variety characteristics:

Type: hybrid
Use: oil
Maturity: very early
Growing type: tendril type

Agronomic properties:

Youth development: 5 (medium)
Flowering: 6 (medium-late)
Maturity: 3 (very early)
Viroses: 6 (medium)
Leaf necroses: 6 (medium)
Mildew: 7 (medium)
Fruit rot: 5 (good)

Yield potential/yield structure:

1000 grain weight: medium ~ 199 gr.
Yield level 780 - 1000kg/ha
Oil content: ~49.5%

Crop management:

Sowing rate: 1.5 – 1.8 grains/m²
Sowing technique: single grain sowing with row spacing of 0,7 – 1,4m
Sowing time: end of April – mid of May
Fertilization information: 0-90kg N / 120kg P₂O₅ / 160kg K₂O
Harvest: begin of September

Variety description:

GL INKA is a pumpkin hybrid which has a very early maturity. Nevertheless GL INKA is really healthy in leaves and fruit, and gives stabile grain yield. With GL INKA you can start harvest earlier!
