GL RUSTIKAL

Highest yield – lowest fruit rot

- **High yield in grain and oil**
- **Very stable yield of years and areas**
- **Dark green, skinless grains**

Variety characteristics:

Type: hybrid
Use: oil
Maturity: medium – late
Growing type: between bush and tendril type

Agronomic properties:

Youth development: 5 (fast)
Flowering: 4 (medium)
Maturity: 5 (medium-late)
Viroses: 5 (good)
Leaf necroses: 5 (good)
Mildew: 6 (good)
Fruit rot: 4 (good)



Yield potential/Yield structure:

1000 grain weight: very high ~216 gr.
Yield level: 900 – 1000kg/ha
oil content: ~48,4% (in dry material)

Crop management:

Sowing rate: 1.5 – 1.8 grains/m²
Sowing technique: single grain sowing with row spacing between 0.7m and 1.4m
Sowing time: end of April – mid of May
Fertilization information: 0-90kg N / 120kg P₂O₅ / 160kg K₂O
Harvest: end of September

Variety description:

RUSTIKAL is the most popular oil pumpkin at the moment. The yield is very high and stable. The grains are big, dark green and full of oil.
