

Gleisdorfer Ölkürbis

The traditional oil pumpkin variety

- Suitable for all locations, areas and soil types
- Easy to separate the grains from the fruit
- Robust plants – long sprout type

1000 grain weight: medium-small ~185gr.
Yield level: 700 – 900kg
oil content: ~47% (in dry material)

Crop management:

Sowing rate: 1.5 – 1.8 grains/m²
Sowing technique: single grain sowing with row spacing of 1,4 - 2,1m
Sowing time: end of April – mid of May
Fertilization information: 0-90kg N / 120kg P₂O₅ / 160kg K₂O
Harvest: middle of September

Variety description:

GLEISDORFER ÖLKÜRBIS is the traditional variety of the styrian oil pumpkin. The variety has long sprouts, is very robust and can be grown everywhere.
