### Variety characteristics:

Type: hybrid  
 Use: oil-production/linoleic  
 Recommend.: for intensive rape areas

### Agronomic properties:

Winter hardness: 2 very good  
 Spring development: 4 medium-slow  
 Flowering: 6 medium  
 Maturity: 6 medium-late  
 Plant height: 5 short-medium  
 Lodging: 3 very good  
 Phoma: 3 good  
 Sclerotinia: 4 good

### Yield potential/yield structure:

Yield: 8 very high  
 Oil yield: 7 high  
 Oil content: 5 medium-high (41,3%)

### Crop management:

Sowing rate: 50 grains/m<sup>2</sup>  
 Sowing technique: drill sowing like cereals  
 Sowing time: 15 August – 5 September  
 Fertilization information: 2x100kg N / 80kg P<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub> / 200kg K<sub>2</sub>O  
 Harvest: beginning of July

### Variety description:

AURELIA is a new hybrid with the best genetic background you can have at moment - TUYV virus resistance, pod shatter resistance and phoma Rlm7 resistance. AURELIA has very strong, darkgreen plants which develop medium-slow in autumn and spring. Flowering and maturity is medium-late. The plants are medium-short and very healthy. Aurelia shows no lodging, also in very intensive crop management.
