KWARK

The strong & robust hybrid

- slower development in autumn and spring
- medium-late flowering and maturity
- compact growing type, easy harvest

Variety characteristics:

Type: hybrid
Use: oil-production/linoleic
Recommendation: for good areas and soil / early sowing

Agronomic properties:

Winter hardness: 2 very good
Spring development: 3 rather slow
Flowering: 7 medium-late
Maturity: 6 medium-late
Plant height: 5 medium-short
Lodging: 3 very good
Phoma: 4 good
Sclerotinia: 4 good



Yield potential/yield structure:

Yield: 7 very high
Oil yield: 7 very high
Oil content: 6 high
1000 grain weight: 4 medium
Glucosinolat: 4 good

Crop management:

Sowing rate: 50 grains/m²
Sowing technique: drill sowing like cereals
Sowing time: 15 August – 5 September
Fertilization information: 2x100kg N / 80kg P₂O₅ / 200kg K₂O
Harvest: begin of July

Variety description:

Kwark is rape hybrid with rather slow development in autumn and spring. Therefore it is suitable for early sowing and shows very good winter hardiness.

Kwark is a very strong and later type, but not too high and still compact for easy harvest. Almost like a semi-dwarf hybrid!
